1. Welcome and establishment of the quorum

The Presidium welcomed the participants.

Jan Gfrerer replaced Natalia Vergara Hernandez.

There are 20 members present at the meeting. The StuPa therefore has a quorum

2. Approval of the agenda

Fabian Probst, Miriam Hofele and Tobias Lutz asked about the purpose of agenda item 11 and whether it should be included in the minutes. The questions were answered.

The agenda was put to the vote and adopted unanimously.

3. Approval of the minutes of 12.01.2022

There were no changes to the minutes. The minutes were put to the vote and adopted unanimously.

4. Financial requests

There is a financial request from the Working Group for Sustainability (AKN) for the Green Lodge from 28 April to 01 May 2022. The AKN is requesting 2600 € for accommodation, travel costs and material resources.

The Green Lodge is for all students who are interested in the topic of sustainability. During this weekend there will be various workshops and community actions around sustainability at universities.

Tobias Lutz asks whether the hut will also be advertised to the outside world, or whether only the green groups will come along. Judith Blättler answers that the green student groups are the main target group, but that interested parties can also take part.

Emma Kraft asks how much the personal contribution is, which is 40 €.

Tobias Lutz asks whether the amount of 2600 € could be reduced, as the VS would otherwise subsidise more than half of the own contribution. Hanna Tietgen asks for a vote on whether the majority is in favour of the full amount or not.

Vote: For 11; Against 2; Abstentions

Due to the majority in favour of the full amount, the financial proposal is now put to the vote and accepted with 3 abstentions.

5. Report of the AStA

It is made clear that the rules of procedure are not to be finally voted on, but only the draft is to be presented and an opinion is to be obtained.

7. Resolution QSM 2022

Max Witzke reports:

The QSM amount to 600,000 € in this distribution round. The list of applications is presented and how many applications were approved.

The decision of the QSM is put to the vote and adopted unanimously.

9. Report of the committees

Sustainability

An ideas workshop was held on 16.01.2022 and plans were made for what projects are coming up next, such as the Green Hut or the Sustainability Weeks.

The Sustainable Monday has dealt with topics such as food sharing in the last few weeks. There was also an active listening workshop and an inclusive talk on ecology.

Senate meeting

MWK is providing €700,000 to catch up on learning backlogs caused by the Corona Pandemic. A paper was also passed clearly advocating for attendance in the summer semester.

The VS is also to draft a statement in favour of a semester of attendance.

Political education

Consideration for a video project explaining university politics, what committees exist and what is done. Emma Kraft notes that such a project has already been realised in the summer semester 2020 and that the videos can be used again.

Presidium

Meeting of the AStA and StuPa boards with the Chancellor Ms Scheffer. It was discussed that the rooms of the student councils and the AStA should be used sensibly.

The topic of online elections was addressed with the question of whether the VS can make a certain financial contribution to financing the online elections, as the student elections are also co-financed.

10. Miscellaneous

Nayana Kramer asks that it be forwarded that a student member is being sought for the Deutschlandstipendium. It is about reviewing the applications. However, the person is not allowed to apply for the scholarship and should not have received the scholarship yet.

The scholarship holders have until 25 February to let us know.

Hauke Delfs reports that the contribution rules were decided some time ago, but the decision may still take some time.

Nayana Kramer notes that the circulation procedures should be voted on promptly. It is sufficient to send back an email with a "yes" or "no". Half of the members must vote, otherwise the vote is invalid.
